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SAFETY

NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Your ARB BASE RACK has a maximum carrying capacity of 150kg for the 6 leg model and 100kg for the 4 leg model. This load should not be exceeded and all loads must be tied down securely.

It is important to follow the listed usage instructions:

- ◆ The vehicle owner's manual should be consulted prior to loading the roof rack as the manufacturer's recommended maximum load for the vehicle's roof may be less than the maximum load specified for the roof rack and must not be exceeded.
- ◆ Calculation for permissible cargo:

$$6 \text{ leg kit: } \frac{\text{Vehicle max or 150kg}}{(\text{whichever is less})} - \frac{10kg}{(\text{kit weight})} - \frac{\text{rack weight}}{(\text{refer to box})} = \text{Net Payload}$$

$$4 \text{ leg kit: } \frac{\text{Vehicle max or 100kg}}{(\text{whichever is less})} - \frac{6.5kg}{(\text{kit weight})} - \frac{\text{rack weight}}{(\text{refer to box})} = \text{Net Payload}$$

- ◆ The maximum load per Base Rack cross beam is 25kg.
- ◆ Load must be evenly distributed and adequately secured.
- ◆ Any weight carried on the roof of the vehicle will adversely affect its handling, particularly in cornering or in a cross-wind, the vehicle should therefore be driven with increased discretion.
- ◆ Regularly check the tightness of the securing clamps and the security of the load.
- ◆ Attention is directed to statutory requirements regarding maximum permissible projections from vehicles.

All bolts should be checked prior to touring to ensure the rack is fastened correctly













Air Deflector and Base Rack Light Bar

An air deflector or Base Rack Light Bar should be fitted beneath the front edge of the Base Rack. Refer to the table below for the correct part number. If fitting the light bar in front of the Base Rack, an Air Deflector should also be fitted. Refer to the instructions provided with these products for further details.





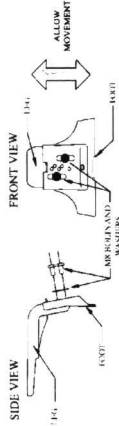
FITTING PROCEDURE

	<p>1. Place the BASE RACK on a stand, base up. The logo should be upside down</p>
	<p>2. Measure approximate widths of the roof gutters front and rear, and record</p>
	<p>3. The length of the rack and number of legs will determine leg position. There should be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No more than 1 rung over hanging from each end. • No more than 2 rungs between supports. • Preference towards the rear of the vehicle if uneven mounting positions must be used. • Preference towards mounting above pillars where possible

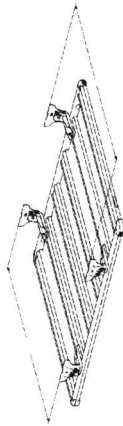
	<p>4. Insert the M8 studs into the stud plate</p> <p>5. Drop the stud plate into the extrusion, rotate 90° to lock</p>
	<p>6. The support plate can be fitted in two positions depending on the width of the vehicle</p> <p>7. Align the leg with one of the small holes in the Support Plate and locate using the supplied x-mas tree plug</p> <p>8. Slide the plate and leg over the studs in the BASE RACK and loosely fasten with the washer plate and M8 nuts</p>
	<p>9. Place the compliance label on the rear driver's side leg in the location shown. Rub firmly to ensure adhesion.</p>

FITTING PROCEDURE

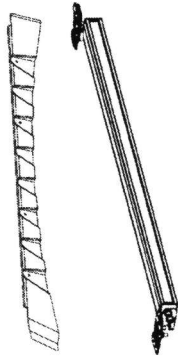
10. Fasten a foot to each leg (in its highest position) by passing M8 x 16mm hex head bolts and M8 washers through the foot slots into the captive nuts in the leg. Do not fully tighten, allowing movement



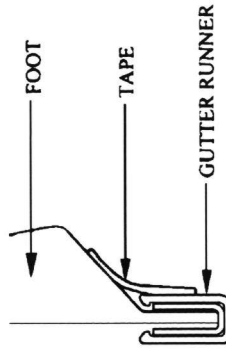
11. Set the width of the feet as measured on the vehicle previously



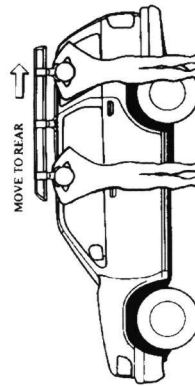
12. At this point the air deflector or light bar should be fitted. Refer to the instructions supplied with the product.



13. The gutter runners provided then fit directly onto each foot. It is recommended to temporarily tape the gutter runners to each foot as shown

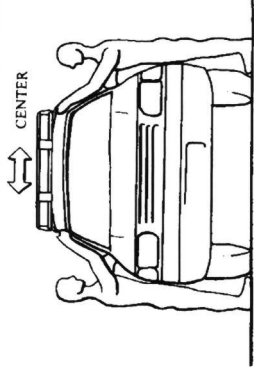


14. Once these procedures have been followed the rack can be lifted into position on your vehicle. It is advisable to use 4 people. The rack should be positioned with the gutter runner in the vehicle gutter. ARB recommends position the rack towards the rear of the vehicle as shown

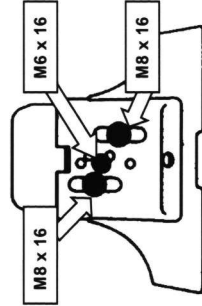


FITTING PROCEDURE

15. At this stage it is best to step back and view whether the rack is centred. As the width adjustment is not fully tightened the rack should be moved until it is centred over the vehicle. Refer to diagram shown

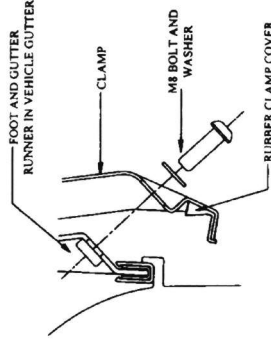


16. The feet should then be angled to sit flat in the vehicle gutter
17. Lock the leg and foot together by fastening the M6x16 bolt, washer and flange nut through one of the available holes as shown
18. Tighten M6 and M8 fasteners
19. The nuts connecting the legs to the BASE RACK can now be fully tightened to fix the width.



-  Torque M6 to 9Nm
-  Torque M8 to 22Nm

20. To complete fitment place the rubber clamp covers onto the clamps. Fasten the rack to the vehicle gutters using the rubber covered clamps and M8 x 30mm socket head bolts and washers. The bolts pass through the slots in the clamps into the captive nuts in the feet. This pulls the clamps both up and into the vehicle gutter. Excessive over tightening of these bolts may result in damage to the vehicle gutter.
